A week mixing cutting-edge teaching and research activities within a contemporary topic targeted towards our first year Bachelor of International Management students ESSCA School of Management will be organizing its first International Week next Spring on its Parisian Campus, from March 19th to March 24th, 2022.

The visiting professors will have the opportunity to teach courses in their respective areas to groups of students from our Bachelor in International Management. • International Business (implications of COP 27 for business models, sustainable international business development, ethics – diversity and inclusion in business)

• Marketing (responsible and sustainable consumption, circular economy, ethical issues in marketing and consumption, ethics in digital marketing)

• Finance (sustainable finance, green finance, ethics finance)

We expect to hold the entire week with face-to-face teaching and activities (except the Opening Masterclass that will be held online and broadcasted on our campus). We will have two sessions (on Thursday tbc) dedicated to research where you will be able to present a paper based on your research and connect with ESSCA professors working on similar issues as well as networking events.

ESSCA will be covering a welcome dinner on Sunday, lunches from Monday to Thursday and a farewell dinner on Thursday evening and cultural activities during the week. Selected professors will be paid 680€ for 7h30 of teaching and 2 hours of student restitution supervision.
