MINUTES N. 1

On the 7th of September, 2021, from 2:30 pm to 6:00 pm, via Microsoft Teams the Selection Committee of the “Concorso” for admission onto the PhD programme in "Management, Finance and Accounting (hereinafter referred to as "the programme") - XXXVII cycle" appointed by the Rectoral Decree n. 790 of August 30th, 2021, held its first meetings of the “Concorso” to which it applied the legislative provisions on public “Concorsi”.

The Selection Committee was composed as follows:

- Prof. Valentina Lazzarotti, Active President,
- Prof. Alberto Bubbio, Active Member,
- Prof. Rossella Pozzi, Active Member,
- Prof. Fernanda Strozzi, Active Member,
- Prof. Patrizia Tettamanzi, Active Member.

The President stated that -by the deadline indicated in the Call - 21 applications had been received (see Attachment n. 1).

The Committee recorded the absence of incompatibility, pursuant to articles. 51 and 46 of the Civil Procedure Code, among its members and between them and the applicants.



The Committee verified all the requirements, pursuant to articles 5 and 6, and excluded from the evaluation all the 12 incomplete applications (see Attachment n. 2).

The Committee noted that, pursuant to article 7, the Call was published in the Official Gazette, 4th special series, n. 56 of July 16th, 2021, and that the three criteria to be eligible for the PhD Program are defined according to the following profiles:

- a) knowledge and skills to successfully deal with the topics of the Program; aptitude of the candidate for scientific research and consistency of his/her scientific profile with respect to the main topics of the doctoral Program and specific research project on the topic referred to in Article 1 of the Call;
- b) ability in discussing and interpreting phenomena related to the economic, financial or managerial engineering fields, also expressed in quantitative terms, as well as linguistic competence suitable to participate in the activities of the Program.

Profile a) is assessed by considering the university career of the applicant, as well as any other titles or aspects of their personal CV useful to demonstrate their skills and knowledge.

Profile b) is assessed on the basis of the publications, participation in projects / research groups, results of internationally recognized tests (such as the GRE or the GMAT), if taken, and the preparation of a Statement of Purpose that clarifies the candidate's research interests (in this regard, please see the website <http://www.liuc.it/phd> for specific drafting rules) and the paper outlining the development of a possible research project on the topic referred to in Article 1 of the Call.

Profile c) is assessed on the basis of an oral exam, in English.

According to the call, the Committee stated that, given an overall score of 45 points, the specific score for each profile is the following:

- Profile a): up to a maximum of 15 points;
- Profile b): up to a maximum of 15 points;
- Profile c): up to a maximum of 15 points

Applicants are considered eligible for admission to the Program if they achieve a score at least equal to 30 points and provided that the score is at least 10 points for each Profile.



With regard to the profile a), the Committee allocated the available 15 points by using the following criteria:

- Education carrier (e.g. graduation score)
- Postgraduate education and professional experience
- Recommendation letters

With regard to the profile b), the Committee allocated the available 15 points by using the following criteria:

- Statement of Purpose (SOP)
- Specific research project
- Internationally recognised tests
- Publications and participation in research projects/networks

With regard to the profile c), the Committee will evaluate the ability in discussing and interpreting economic financial or managerial engineering phenomena, as well as the language proficiency showed during the interview.

After careful reading and analysis of the curricula, certifications and additional information reported in the application form of each candidate, the Committee selected the following candidates to be admitted to the interview:
